**Level 4 Progression options:**

1. Wait for exams to return – No confirmed date from AAT as yet
2. Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) – Exam fee will be charged
  - This option is not available for synoptic exams
  - At a set time, complete an assessment written by Peak which will cover all learning outcomes within the unit. This option is not available for all units at Level 4 – currently only available for MABU, MDCL, and FSLC.
  - Assessment will be provided 15 mins by email before the start time of the assessment and must be returned to Peak within 15 mins of the end time.
  - Assessment marked and feedback provided by Peak assessor within 5 working days of submitting the assessment.
  - If 70% or more is achieved in the assessment, a professional discussion on Zoom would then be carried out between the student and Peak assessor to strengthen any weak areas within the assessment and to confirm authenticity of the completed assessment.
  - Competence must be demonstrated in 100% of learning outcomes in order to achieve a unit using RPL
  - Once all completed and evidence has been internally verified you would be awarded a pass grade for that unit – equivalent to a score of 70% which will show on the AAT statement of achievement.
  - This option can only be completed for 50% of a level, so for a L4 accountancy student 3 exams can be completed as this is up to 50% of the level 4 accountancy qualification. This option cannot be used for a synoptic exam at any level.
